Gordon Sumner (also known as Sting), a musician, was born and raised in the shadow of a shipyard in a little town on the northeast coast of England. His earliest memories were of giant ships at the end of the street, blocking out the sun. Every morning, what he did was look at thousands of people doing the backbreaking labor of building giant vessels that would transport cargo, soldiers, or guests across the world’s seas. Although the shipyard was noisy, dangerous and highly toxic, the men and women who worked on those ships were **extraordinarily** proud of the work they did. Thus, Gordon’s father wanted his own son to become one of them.

Gordon Sumner was accustomed to the life of the shipyard; however, he had his own dreams, the ones that took him far from the grimy port of his youth. After leaving his hometown, Gordon registered for the University of Warwick in Coventry, but quit school very quickly. Later, Gordon worked as a bus conductor, tax officer and even a teacher in the daytime, whereas he performed jazz during evenings and weekends. Gordon had successfully written his life’s story in his songs, and these songs struck a chord with millions of fans. From Gordon’s memoir, in addition to the elements of rock, jazz, reggae, classical, new-age and worldbeat in music, Gordon’s backstory wrapped in the events had helped him receive 17 Grammy Awards and other big prizes. The leopard cats are the only surviving native wild cat after the disappearance of the Formosan clouded leopard. They are roughly the size of housecats and live in Taiwan's lower elevations of around 500 meters. Areas mixing wilderness with agriculture are particularly hospitable for them as rice fields provide ideal habitats for leopard cats' favorite prey, such as field mice and other rodents. While the species is very common across a wide range of habitats from Pakistan to Siberia and the Indonesian archipelago, it is on the edge of extinction in Taiwan. It is estimated that there are less than 500 of them divided into three isolated populations in Miaoli, Taichung, and Nantou.

Habitat destruction is the biggest threat to leopard cats. Road building and some development programs are destroying their habitat seriously. Two years ago, for example, construction began in a wetland park in Chuo Lan in the name of economic development, and yet it destroyed their natural habitat. Although the construction has stopped, it has already caused great damage. What's worse, there are some other development projects besides the park. As for road building, the news that leopard cats have been killed in traffic accidents is not strange.

Moreover, to hunt for survival, they often innocently and miserably fall victim to poisoning by chicken farm owners. Thus, wildlife biologists keep promoting raising chickens in coops and growing rice without pesticide.

Luckily, the leopard cat population in Nantou seems to be more secure, as the local residents there have been long used to the presence of TESRI(特有生物保育研究中心). Born in Taiwan, Andre Chiang was named the Rising Chef of the Year for 2009 at the World Gourmet Summit Awards of Excellence. He was only 33 years old then. The characteristics of being mentally strong, hardworking and goal-oriented make him become extraordinary in the field. In high school, he volunteered to work in one famous French restaurant in Taipei only to gain precious experiences. Inspired by the then-French-chef, he decided to dedicate his career to French cuisine. He worked hard and saved a big portion of his salary to buy the latest magazines and books about cooking.

When Andre was 20, he became the youngest chef of French cuisine in Taiwan. However, he was not contented. He gave up his handsome-paid job, sold his motorbike and flew to France to work at the three Michelin-starred restaurant *Le Jardin des Sens*. In his first year working in that restaurant, he worked from 5 am till midnight every day but got no pay. He never complained about it; instead, he was grateful for being able to work and learn in the “dream kitchen.” With a strong will and passion, he survived the first year even though he didn't speak any French. He continued to work six more years in *Le Jardin des Sens* until his bosses assigned him to extend new branch restaurants in Asia, including Tokyo, Bangkok, Shanghai and Singapore.

Even though Andre has got a really tight schedule every day, he has kept his reading habit. In his autobiography, Andre recalled, “I seldom read recipes, which might limit my ideas and curb my creativity. Rather, I read books about architecture, arts and history so as to enrich myself.” Through his experiences and reading, he came up with the “Octo-philosophy,” in which he used eight elements, or concepts, to make up his dishes. He always knew what his next goal was. In 2014, he returned to his hometown Taipei, and opened a brand new restaurant *RAW*. A “meatless war” is going on in the food industry. Products from two rising stars, Beyond Meat and Impossible Foods, seem to have sprung up everywhere. In supermarkets, grocery stores, fast food restaurants and online shops, consumers have easy access to these “meat patties,” “sausages,” and “ground meat,” all of which are made from plants.

The development of plant-based meat production is good for the earth. Growing demand for meat is actually doing harm to the earth. It is shocking but true that nearly half of the land surface has been used for raising livestock and growing crops to feed **them**. Animal agriculture releases the most greenhouse gases, causes the most water pollution, and destroys forests, threatening the existence of wildlife. Compared to traditionally produced meat from animals, plant-based meat presents a sharp decline in the use of land, in gas emissions, and in freshwater consumption. Therefore, a plant-based diet can help fight climate change and improve animal welfare.

To meat-lovers’ satisfaction, both Beyond Meat and Impossible Foods are now capable of producing healthy and delicious products with the taste and texture of real meat. The meat patties are made from a blend of soy, potatoes and rice protein, mixed with sunflower oil or coconut oil. The protein from plants provides the texture of meat. In addition, beet juice extract is used to give the “meat” pink color, which makes it look like the blood in beef. Both Beyond Meat and Impossible Foods have claimed that their products are free from hormones, antibiotics, and cholesterol. Finally yet importantly, the two companies went through different challenges while trying to get certifications of being vegan. Vegans are advised to pay special attention when making buying decisions.

Both Beyond and Impossible provide consumers with a substitute for traditional meat. With the increasing popularity of these products, there is hope that people can lower the dependence on animal products and expect a more sustainable environment for the next generation.

Apart from February 14, Japan celebrates another Valentine's Day –White Day. White Day falls on March 14, a month after Valentine's Day.

The first record of White Day appeared in the 1970s. In Japan, it is women who are supposed to present chocolates to men on Valentine's Day. In 1977, the sweets company Ishimura Manseido thought of an idea and created "Marshmallow Day" to market marshmallows to men on March 14. Although the business idea did not become a hit, the National Confectionery Industry Association sensed the opportunity and invented White Day as an "answer day" to Valentine's Day, encouraging men to return the favor to women. It is believed that the color white was selected because of its symbolic meaning of purity. Since then, the custom of White Day has been spread throughout Japan as well as its neighboring countries like Korea and Taiwan.

On White Day, men are normally expected to return gifts at least two or three times more valuable than what they received a month earlier. If a woman does not receive a gift in return, it is considered a rude rejection from the man. A gift of equal value is still regarded as a sign that the man wishes to cut the relationship.

There are some interesting rules about the implications of White Day sweets in certain areas of Japan. For example, marshmallows used to be popular, but now they are being avoided with the meaning of "I dislike you." As crunchy cookies indicate a "casual" relationship, sending cookies means "We are nothing more than friends." Lastly, candies mean "I like you," because compared to marshmallows and cookies, candies last for longer periods of time.

一場「無肉戰爭」正在食品業界開打。兩家新星：超越肉類公司(Beyond Meat)以及不可能食品(Impossible Foods)，似乎已經遍地開花。在超市、雜貨店、速食店以及網路商店，消費者很容易可以買到這些「肉餅」、「香腸」與「絞肉」，這些全部都是植物做成的。

植物肉製造業的發展對地球而言是好的。對肉類不斷增加的需求實際上正在傷害地球。令人震驚但卻千真萬確的是，地表將近一半的土地都被用在飼養牲畜以及種植用來餵養牠們的農作物。畜牧業排放最多溫室氣體，引起最多水汙染，破壞森林，威脅野生動物的生存。與傳統從動物身上生產肉類相比，植物肉在土地使用、溫室氣體排放、耗水量等都呈現大幅下降。因此，植物肉的飲食方式可以幫助對抗氣候變遷，並且改善動物福祉。

令無肉不歡者滿意的是，超越肉類公司和不可能食品現在都能製造健康又美味，具有真肉口感及口味的產品。肉餅混合了大豆、馬鈴薯、米類的蛋白質，再以葵花油或椰子油調和。植物性蛋白質提供了肉的口感。此外，甜菜汁的萃取物被用來使「肉」有粉紅色，使其看起來像牛肉裡面的鮮血。超越肉類公司和不可能食品這兩家公司都宣稱他們的產品不含荷爾蒙、抗生素與膽固醇。最後但卻重要的是，這兩家公司在試圖取得素食認證時經歷了不同的挑戰。建議素食者在決定採購時要特別留意。

除了二月 14 日，日本還慶祝另一個情人節—白色情人節。白色情人節在三月 14 日，情人節過後一個月。
