



The Nutrition Facts label is required by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) on most packaged foods and beverages. The Nutrition Facts label provides detailed information about a food's nutrient content, such as the amount of fat, sugar, sodium and fiber it has. 

More than 700 million people, or 10% of the world population live in extreme poverty today. Females and young girls are particular groups that need real help. For example, women and girls in certain areas cannot even afford their menstrual(生理期的) products, such as sanitary pads or napkins. It's hard to imagine that they have to use broken, old rags or straw rather than safe period products. This reality puts girls in developing countries at risk for infection, sickness and other health problems.

We are in the COVID-19 pandemic, and we have no idea when this is going to end. To understand the situation, the KFF (Kaiser Family Foundation) did a survey on March 11-15, 2020 and surprisingly found that there were some differences in how men and women respond to the pandemic. First of all, more women than men said that their lives had been bothered by the pandemic (49% vs. 40%). Next, women, compared with men, were more likely to stay home instead of going to work or other regular activities (81% vs. 69%). Women would rather choose to change or cancel their travel plans than men (72% vs. 66%) or to shelter in the current location (88% vs. 76%). In fact, when the outbreak became more severe (two weeks after the first poll taken), KFF did a second survey—one sex gap has gotten strikingly larger, particularly among parents. Women overall were 16 percentage points more likely than men to say that worry or stress related to coronavirus had a negative impact on their mental health. Among parents of children under age 18, the sex gap reached a striking 25%. In the poll taken just two weeks prior, namely, in the first survey, the sex gap among all adults was 9 percentage points (36% vs. 27%) and among parents, it was just 5 percentage points (36% vs. 31%). To conclude, women are more likely to worry about both the health and economic effects of a pandemic on their families, and the worry would become even more if they have children under 18.

Musical ‘Jekyll & Hyde’ to hit the stage with new cast

One of the most anticipated musicals in Korea this year will be staged for about half a year from December. A new production of “Jekyll & Hyde” will feature a new cast including actor Shin Sung-rok.

The 170-minute show is based on the 1886 novel “Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde” by Robert Louis Stevenson. Set in 19th century London, the story centers on Dr. Jekyll, who struggles between his dual personalities of good Jekyll and evil Hyde. Dr. Jekyll attempts to separate the evil self from his personality. The musical has gained great popularity in Korea for its detailed descriptions of characters and dramatic music and lyrics by Frank Wildhorn. Since its Broadway debut in 1997 and premier in Korea in 2004, the show has been staged over 1,410 times in Seoul and has sold 1.5 million tickets.

In this production, the three actors, Ryu Jung-han, Hong Kwang-ho and Shin Sung-rok, will take turns playing the leading role of Jekyll/Hyde since the musical lasts six months. It is challenging to perform the inner conflict of the main character. Ryu has been playing the leading role since the musical’s premiere in 2004, while Hong has been performing the role since 2008. New to the team, Shin is also a successful actor in numerous musicals and TV shows.

大多數通勤者在上班或上學時都會受到周圍噪音的困擾。一副降噪耳機或許能解決此問題。這款電子設備讓您能聽音樂放鬆，阻隔惱人外部聲音。戴上耳機，您將能夠聽到更好的聲音。大部分的型號也能讓你單單戴上耳機，完全不播放，也能享有平和寧靜。降噪耳機是根據什麼原理呢？

該技術背後的物理原理是，聲音都以波的形式傳播，可用振幅、波長和頻率來描述之。抗噪耳機能夠消除不想要的聲音，乃是藉由製造出一個完全相反的新波形，該波形模仿你不想要之聲音的波形，但是 180° 異相。也就是說，一個聲波在最高點的波峰時，另一個聲波在最低點的波谷，有效彼此互相抵銷。要做到這一點，需要麥克風。隱藏在耳罩中的麥克風會捕捉周圍的噪音，然後電路系統會產生「異相」的聲波，傳給耳機的喇叭。耳機產生的音波掩蓋外部噪音，而不會影響您正在聽的音樂。

耳機無法完全消除短促而突然性的聲音，例如嬰兒哭聲或狗吠，但是使用這種方法可以阻擋大約 70% 的環境噪音。只要記住給耳機的電池充電；所有電子設備都需要電力才能發揮功能。

如果你去立陶宛的考納斯一遊，可能會聽到「杉原」這個名字很多次。事實上，在立陶宛，2020 年是「杉原千畝年」。為什麼這位日本人在立陶宛那麼有名呢？

杉原(千畝)是第一位派駐於立陶宛的日本外交官。1939 年二戰爆發時，杉原千畝被任命為駐考納斯的副領事。他的工作是密切觀察日本盟友德國並蒐集情報。此時，納粹坦克已經大舉開進鄰國波蘭，造成猶太難民逃往立陶宛。蘇聯在 1940 年六月入侵立陶宛後，許多猶太人湧進日本大使館，想取得過境簽證，透過日本逃到安全之地。雖然東京的外務省不允許杉原核發簽證，但是杉原決定違抗政府的命令，因為他無法坐視立陶宛的猶太人自生自滅。他開始為有需要的人核發過境簽證。1940 年夏天連續六週，杉原盡可能核發簽證，有時候一天工作十八個小時。大使館關閉後，他搬到考納斯市中心的旅館，繼續核發簽證。同年九月四日，他搭火車離開考納斯，前往德國。在正式的文件記載中，共核發了 2139 份簽證，但是專家估計，杉原可能救了六千名猶太人的性命，因為很多情況下，一張簽證全家同行。杉原所發的簽證就是所謂的「救命簽證」。

然而，戰後，杉原被政府辭退，1950 到 1960 年代，他在日本的沿海小鎮經商為生。他對於自己核發簽證所拯救的性命隻字未提。1985 年，以色列表揚杉原的行為，尊崇他為「國際義人」。1986 年杉原過世，他二戰期間的人道行為引起大眾關注，藉此機會平反他在母國身為外交官的名聲。
